After graduation from Bolivar High School, she attended Southwest Baptist College and taught school for a short time in a one room school in Cliquot, Missouri. While teaching in Cliquot, she met and fell in love with Marvin Payne of Polk, Missouri.

Freda and Marvin Payne were married on November 2, 1946. To this union, Carolyn Sue and Marvin Doyle were born while Freda and Marvin resided in Springfield, Missouri.
