November 25, 1919 - June 8, 2011

Adron Jackson Jack Ikerd, 91, Bolivar, died Wednesday, June 08, 2011 at Citizens Memorial Healthcare Facility. The son of Homer and Maggie (Jenkins) Ikerd, he was born in Conway, Missouri November 25, 1919. Jack was a U. S. Army veteran of World War II serving in the South Pacific. Jack and Jewell Seamster were married June 16, 1946 in Polk. She preceded him in death January 10, 2009. His parents, great-grandson, Dakota Moore, brother, Henry Ikerd, and sisters, Alice Derossett, Marie Gilben, Frances Carter and Lucy Reminga, also preceded him in death. Jack was a machinist, welder and mechanic. He was also an inventor and graduated from Fort Smith Auction School in July 1977. He had been a member of the V. F. W.
