



Albert E. Cortner

August 24, 1917 - April 14, 2007

Albert Edmond Cortner, 89, Bolivar, died Saturday, April 14, 2007 in Citizens Memorial Healthcare Facility. The son of Albert E. and Pearl May Harp Cortner, he was born in the Shady Grove community, south of Fair Play, August 24, 1917. Following graduation from high school, he went to work as a mechanic. During World War II from March 18, 1941 to November 15, 1945 he served in the U. S. Army in the 885th Ordnance Company in Burma and India. Following his return from the army, he was a mechanic for Roberts Chevrolet until 1949 and then mechanic for Crain Pontiac until 1955 when he opened Cortner s Garage which he operated until his retirement in 1979. On September 21, 1947 he and Addie Novela Lynch Clark were married. She preceded him in death December 30, 1999. Also preceding him in death were his father in 1926, his mother in 1934, a brother, Robert Cortner, and a sister, Ammie Williams. Survivors include two sons, Charles Clark, Seymour and Sherley Clark, Springfield; a brother, Eugene Cortner and wife, Johnelle, Houston, TX; 2 sisters, Bernice Neill, Fair Play and Maxine Spencer and husband, Tom, Stockton; two granddaughters, Janet Mosier and Brenda Clark, both of Springfield; and several nieces and nephews. Funeral services will be 2:00 PM Tuesday, April 17, 2007 in Murray Funeral Home, Bolivar. Visitation will be Tuesday from 1:00 to 2:00 PM. Interment will be in Crestview Memorial Gardens
