Albert Justin Floyd, 64, Humansville, died Sunday June 27, 2010 at Northwood Hills Care Center, Humansville. The son of Justin and Essel (MacAllister) Floyd, he was born in Baton Rouge, Louisiana July 17, 1945. Albert and Irma Hague were married June 18, 1971.
