Karen Annette Euliss Turner, aged 49, of Morrisville, died Friday, Sept. 8, 2017 at CMH in Bolivar, MO.

Born in Springfield, MO, the daughter of Jerry and Sue Euliss. She grew up in Morrisville and graduated from Marion C Early HS. She attended Southwest MO State University.

She met John Turner during college, they were married June 23, 1990 and resided near her family in Morrisville where they raised three sons.

For a few years she ran a daycare and cared for many children in the Morrisville community. Later she worked for Council of Churches of the Ozarks as a director of the Childcare Food Program. She also monitored daycares throughout the state.

Annette loved camping with her family, floating the rivers, fishing and watching her boys ball games. She especially loved holding babies.

Preceding her in death was her brother, Russ Euliss, then grandparents: Cecil and Helen Euliss; and Paul and Martha Hensley.
