Mrs. Atsy Leah Eads, 102, Weaubleau, died Tuesday, August, 18, 2009 in Christian Health Care of Nixa. The daughter of James Henry and Beatrice Virginia (Murphy) Breshears, she was born at Avery in Hickory county. During World War II she worked in a garment factory making uniforms for soldiers. She was a baker at bakeries in Kansas City and volunteered to work in the kitchen at church camp each summer. Atsy was a member of Bethel Tabernacle Assembly of God in Kansas City. She lived on a farm west of Collins for 25 years before moving to Weaubleau where she lived for 24 years. She lived in her own home until over the age of 100 and for the past 1 years she had resided at Christian Healthcare of Nixa. She was married to Robert H. Eads and they were the parents of 2 children, Wallace Eads and June Chambers. Survivors include 9 grandchildren; many great-grandchildren and great-greatgrandchildren. Funeral services will be held at 1:00 PM Saturday, August 22, 2009 in Murray Funeral Home, Humansville with Rev. Joe Mezzacasa officiating. Interment will be in Robinson Cemetery west of Weaubleau.
