Charles Lee Chuck Neill, 52, Bolivar, died Saturday, December 26, 2009 after suffering a massive heart attack on Christmas morning. Chuck was born March 26, 1957 in Springfield, Missouri, the son of James Alden and June (Belcher) Neill. He was raised in Dunnegan and graduated from Fair Play High School. He was employed at Teters Floral Products in maintenance, Chuck was a long-time dirt track race fan, growing up watching the races at Humansville and Springfield and also racing a factory stock around the local dirt tracks from 2001 to 2003. A racing vacation in September to Boone, Iowa with friends confirmed his belief that dirt is the only way to race. He rarely missed a race at Lucas Oil Speedway. He also enjoyed following the Fair Play basketball and baseball teams and watching his nephew play. Chuck and Paula Garrett were married October 18, 1996, sharing the same anniversary as his parents.
