Charley B. Mitchem, Sr., 87, Humansville, passed October 16, 2010. He was born August 21, 1923 in Dunnegan to James and Prudy (Barnes) Mitchem. He attended elementary school at New Home School in Dunnegan and later attended Fair Play High School. Charley served his country in the United States Army Air Force during World War II. After his service he worked for the U. S. Postal Service in the train station in St. Louis where he met Della Gladys Thorsland. They married on August 21, 1947 and returned to Humansville in 1949 where he remained until his death. Charley was employed by the phone company for 7 years and retired from Empire District Electric with over 30 years service as a line foreman in Humansville. He was a member of the Humansville Christian Church. Charley's passion was working in the shop which was located on his farm. He enjoyed helping his friends and neighbors and running around the farm on the Putt-Putt. His parents, James and Prudy Mitchem, wife, Della Gladys Mitchem, son Jerry Lee Mitchem and 11 brothers and sisters.
