The victim of an apparent homicide, his body was found Saturday, October 20, 2007 in the 900 block of South Pike Street in Bolivar. A 2006 graduate of Bolivar High School, he was a member of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. His grandfather, Ralph Cornell, preceded him in death. Survivors include his parents, Sherrie Cornell and Ronald Damron, Bolivar; his maternal grandmother, JoAnn Cornell, Bolivar; 1 brother, Ryan Damron; 7 aunts; 6 uncles; and many cousins. Funeral services will be 1:00 PM, Friday, October 26, 2007 in Murray Funeral Home, Bolivar. Interment will be in Pleasant Ridge Cemetery, Aldrich. Visitation will be Wednesday from 6:00 to 8:00 PM.
