Mr. Clark Waldo Woodmansee, age 92 of Bolivar, MO went home to the Lord on Monday morning, December 14, 2009 at the Citizens Memorial Healthcare Facility in Bolivar.

He was born in a sod house in Mullinsville, KS the son of Ray Woodmansee and Hazel (Stephens) Woodmansee on April 9, 1917.
