Clyde Sellers, 95, Bolivar, died at 7:45 am November 3, 2011 at the Parkview Health Care Facility of Bolivar. He was born on August 29, 1916, in Smallette Missouri. Clyde was the son of Ernest Eugene Sellers and Della Lula Fulton Sellers. One of seven (7) children, Clyde was preceded in death by Earl, Opal, Raymond, Herman, and Alma. Surviving is one brother, Leon, of Pueblo, Colorado. Clyde married Mary Lucinda Greene in August of 1939 in Arkansas. To this union two sons were born; Gary and Bob.
