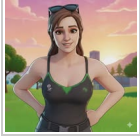

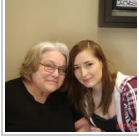
“ I worked with Cora for many years. I will miss her very much. She was a sprite little thing. She could sure show the younger ones how to get the job done.
