Donald (Lou) Spainhower age 78, of Bolivar, MO, passed away March 4, 2011 in his sleep at his home. He was born December 13, 1932 in Oklahoma to Donald and Gladys (Edwards) Spainhower.

Lou graduated with a pharmacy degree from Southwestern State in Weatherford, OK. He served in the US Navy during the Korean Conflict.
