



## Dorothy "Dottie" Lynch Goldsberry

July 5, 1919 - December 18, 2011

Dorothy Dottie Lynch Goldsberry, age 92, a longtime resident of Bolivar, Missouri passed peacefully in her home on Sunday, December 18, 2011.
