Dorothy Mae Hood, of Bolivar, MO, passed away Sunday, September 2, 2007 in her home after a sudden illness.

She was born in Bolivar on January 18, 1924 the daughter of Homer Lon Hood and Marguerite Ann (Mead) Hood.

At the age of 4 months, she and her family moved to Carmen, OK where she attended school there and went one semester to Northwestern State Teachers College in Alva, OK. She then attended Wichita State University for a year and a half. She later went to work for the Southwestern Bell Telephone Co. in Wichita, retired after 37 years as a Service Representative.

Dorothy was baptized on April 20, 1941 in the Carmen Christian Church in Carmen, OK.

Moving to Bolivar in 1983 with her husband Ivy James Hood, they were members of the First Christian Church (Disciples Of Christ) in Bolivar, where Dorothy worked for 7 years as a receptionist.

Dorothy was a 40 year member of the Order Of The Eastern Star in Wichita,

KS.

She loved music and sang in church choirs, since she was 14 years old. She was the Director Of The Youth Church Choir for 30 years. She sang solos, in duets, quartets, glee clubs and played in the band in school and college.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Ivy James Hood on December 19, 1991. Her father, Homer Lon Hood on December 29, 1955 and her mother, Marguerite Ann Hood on February 21, 1985.

Surviving is one sister, Lena Marie Haun of Wichita, KS. Also she considered her church family as her own and will be greatly miss by all.

Funeral services will be held Thursday evening, Sept. 6, 2007 at 7:00 PM in the Butler Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Jerry Book officiating.

Graveside services will be at 1:00 PM Friday, Sept. 7, 2007 at the Old Mission Cemetery in Wichita, KS
