Mrs. Edythe Mae Fellows, 86, Bolivar, died Tuesday, February 17, 2009 in Citizens Memorial Healthcare Facility. The daughter of Henry and Calla Avis (Smith) Hammack, she was born February 20, 1922 at Southwest City, Missouri. She and Jack B. Fellows were married in 1939 at Southwest City. Edythe received her Masters of Religious Education from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary at Fort Worth, Texas. She was a teacher and for 25 years she was a church missions volunteer traveling to 18 countries around the world serving the Lord Jesus Christ. She moved to Bolivar in 2004 from Silver Springs, Maryland and attended First and Calvary Presbyterian Church in Springfield, where Dr. Fellows is an elder and serves on the mission committee. Her parents, a sister, Marjorie Wasson, and brothers, Hubert Milton Hammack, Russell Charles Hammack and Emmette Hammack preceded her in death. Survivors include her husband, Dr. Jack B.
