Mrs. Ruby Estelee Lindsay, age 90 of Springfield, and formerly of Bolivar, passed away at 8:35 PM Friday, January 18, 2008 at the Mercy Villa in Springfield after a short illness.

She was born in Goodson, Dallas County, MO on July 29, 1917, the daughter of John Parscale and Anna (Austin) Parscale.

She married Joseph C. Lindsay on May 25, 1940 in Bolivar, MO. They had one son, Jim, in 1951.

After her marriage to Joe, they lived in Halfway, MO on a farm until they moved to Bolivar upon retirement in 1978. Estelee spent the last year of her life in Mercy Villa in Springfield. She was a homemaker.

Estelee always liked the outdoors and in particular the animals. She reveled in taking long walks and enjoying the animals she would see.

She leaves behind several nieces and other family members, as well as her immediate family who will miss her greatly.
