Ida Fay Wiseman Mullings, 90, of Brighton, much loved mother, died January 15, 2012. She was born March 14, 1921, in Fair Grove, Missouri, to Frank and Pansy Bass Wiseman. On March 23, 1941, she married James E. Mullings and to this union was born 5 children. Fay and Jim were privileged to share almost 61 years together.
