Faye Maxine (Robison) Barham passed away April 20, 2021 at Parkview Healthcare Facility in Bolivar, Mo.

Faye was born December 15, 1928 to James and Grace (Adams) Robison in the Fairview community near Sparta, Mo. She attended grade school at Fairview and graduated from Sparta High School at the age of 16 by skipping 2 grades. She then graduated Draughn's Business College.
