George Wesley Jarman, age 74, of Kansas City, Missouri passed away on Friday, October 23, 2009 at Liberty Hospital in Liberty, Missouri.

He was born September 15, 1935 in Polk County, Missouri to Claude Jarman and Gladys Mary Felthoff Jarman.

He was saved as a young man at the age of 12 in a revival meeting in Ohio. George spent two years in the army, stationed at Ft. Bliss, Texas.
