George Marshall Marsh Shuler, age 77, of Bolivar, Missouri passed away on Thursday morning, November 18, 2010.

He was born September 11, 1933 in Aldrich, Missouri to George Lindsay Shuler and Lucile Geneuve (Davis) Shuler.
