Gerald M. Cook, 82, Dunnegan, passed away Wednesday, November 16, 2011, at Citizens Memorial Hospital, Bolivar. He was the son of John W. and Goldye (Silsby) Cooke. He was born August 25, 1929, in Kansas City, MO. After moving to Flippen, Arkansas, his mother died when he was 1 1/2 years old. Gerald's father passed away when he was 9 years old and he then lived with an uncle for the next 8 years in the Joplin area.
