Harlan Floyd Riggs, 81, of Humansville, passed away Saturday, May 12, 2012, at Mercy Hospital in Springfield. He was one of three sons born to John Harvey and Mary Anne Albert Riggs in Anselmo, Nebraska. Harlan served in the U. S. Army during the Korean War. He married Vernice Robbins on February 13, 1954, and they celebrated their 58th wedding anniversary this past winter. They lived in Sioux City, Iowa, for many years while Harlan worked at the Sioux City Stockyards and then retired after 17 years from the City of Sioux City where he was an equipment operator. He moved to Humansville, Missouri, in July 1998, and made many friends in the area. Harlan was of the Methodist faith and a member of the Vista Methodist Church. He was a member of the Eagles Lodge, Sioux City, Iowa, and a member of the Humansville Senior Center. He enjoyed fishing, dancing at the club, joking and visiting with people.
