Mrs. Harriet Winton McGee, age 89 passed away at Emory Hospital in Atlanta, GA on July 8, 2011.

She was born in Morrisville, MO on July 16, 1921 to Lanta Mae (Gulick) Winton and James Fielding Winton.

She graduated from Central College in Fayette, MO with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1942 and received her Master of Arts degree in English from the University of Missouri in Columbia, MO in 1947.
