June 20, 1932 - March 5, 2012

Helen Nadean Ball, 79, of Humansville, passed away Monday, March 5, 2012, at Cox South Hospital, Springfield. She was born June 20, 1932, near Stockton, Missouri, the daughter of Russell and Lena Gannaway Litle. Helen married Earl Ball on July 26, 1951, in Stockton.
