Hugh Dean Hagar of Macks Creek, MO, age 35, was born November 10, 1970 in Springfield, MO. He was lifted into the arms of his savior on February 24, 2006. He was raised in Halfway, MO.

Hugh graduated in 1989 from Halfway High School. He was very active in basketball, and cross country. He was a member of the F.F.A.. He enjoyed being a team player.

After graduation, he enlisted in the United States Army. He volunteered and proudly served in Desert Storm. Hugh received several medals and commendations. He was honorably discharged, March 1, 1997.

On September 11, 1999, Hugh was united in marriage to Emily Jane Vest. To this union Grace Jane was born. Hugh had a multitude of technical skills.. He was employed at Midwest Aero, where he refinished air planes from across the region. At the time of his death, he was employed with Glava Foam Marine Industries in Camdenton, MO as a welder. He was a master at his craft, certified by the American Welding Society. He enjoyed his workplace and his fellow workers. He had recently returned from a company sponsored ice fishing retreat in Fargo, MN.

Hugh was a member of the Lighthouse Missionary Baptist Church. He was saved and baptized in February 2005. Hugh knew his Bible and stared every morning listening to a sermon on TV. His love of his children, mother and country were the most important aspects of his life. The bond that he shared with his mother gave him the strength to endure all of life's trials and tribulations. He spent all of his spare time with his daughter, Gracie Jane, teaching her the meaning of true love and acceptance of all of God's creatures.

He was preceded in death by his maternal grandparents, Ruth Bays Underwood and Glen Bays, and step-grandfather, Bernard Underwood. Also his paternal grandparents, Perry and Pearl Hagar.
