Irving “Irv” Provencio, 84, died at his home in Bolivar Sunday, December 2, 2012 after a long battle with cancer.

He was born on October 19, 1928 to Alberto and Carmen Provencio in Tucson, Arizona.

He married Diane D. Hurley in Escondido, California on December 5, 1981 he grew up in Tucson and then as a young man ventured to Vera Cruz, Mexico where he worked for several years as a United States Department of Agriculture Livestock Inspector.

After returning to the United States in 1950, he returned to school in Tucson to learn the Barber trade. After working many years as a barber in Tucson, he moved to Escondido, California in 1970. There he and his brother, Art, opened their own shop in 1976 where they worked together until his retirement in 2003.

He was preceded in death by his parents Alberto and Carmen Provencio; sister Helen Halloran of Tucson, Arizona; brother Albert Provencio; sister Rebecca "Tudy" Dominguez; and his brother Rudy Provencio.
