Ivan Milo Johnson, 78, Bolivar, died Thursday, May 17, 2007 in Citizens Memorial Healthcare Facility. The son of Ernest and Nannie Flannery Johnson, he was born at Swan, Missouri April 13, 1929. Ivan was a retired law enforcement officer working for the Kansas City Police Department for 25 years and as a dispatcher in the Polk County Sheriff s Department for 8 years.
