James Franklin Jim Butler, 62, Humansville, died Saturday, November 14, 2009. He was the eldest son of Ralph F. and Rue (Abbott) Butler who preceded him in death. Jim was born on March 19, 1947 in Springfield, MO. Jim was a 1965 graduate of Humansville High School and attended technical school in Nashville, Tennessee. He served in the U. S. Air Force from 1966 to 1970. For several years he was a truck driver and mechanic. He owned and operated Butler Automotive in Humansville for 27 years. He and Donna were married October 10, 1987. Jim was a life member of the National Rifle Association and the Oregon Hunters Club. Hunting and sprint car races were favorites of his. Survivors include his wife, Donna, of the home; son and daughter-in-law Nathan and Brooke Garver and their son, Owen of Bolivar; daughter and son-in-law, Rebecca and Micah Peters and their daughter, Stella, of Salt Lake City, Utah; 2 brothers Jack Butler, Lake View, Oregon and Bill Butler, Bolivar; brother-in-law, Clint Pitts, Flemington; sisters-in-law, Cheryl Butler, June O Grosky, and Sheri Butler; nephews Zach and Adam, niece Jessie; a special uncle and aunt, Ralph and Jerry McQuearry; and a host of extended family and friends.
