She was born Jami Lee Martin, August 11, 1970, in El Dorado Springs, MO. Jami was a loving child with an outgoing personality and sense of humor that brought laughter and happiness to her family and everyone who knew her. During her teenage years, Jami attended school in Lowry City and later Clinton, MO. She attended college in Warrensburg, MO, and later worked in the banking industry as a loan originator. Jami never knew a stranger. People were drawn to her soft-hearted, kind nature and her bubbly, positive personality. Jami was a selfless person, always worrying more about what she could do for someone else, than what they could do for her. It was her ongoing "mission" to guide and watch over her baby sister, Kim. On October 14, 2003, Jami married Tony Green, and their two families became one. Jami spoke many times of the steady, calm influence that Tony had on her life, and how much she depended on him to handle the stresses that she had a hard time dealing with. During the last six months of her life, Jami came home to live with her parents in Weaubleau where she found peace and contentment. Jami had a special relationship with her stepfather, Jim, and always referred to him as her "rock". Jami spent many hours talking with her mother about God and his plan for our lives during her last months, and was at peace, and secure in her relationship with her creator. Her biggest regret was that she would not be here to love and care for her "Baby Bunny", Joey and her "Baby Girl" Katy, as she called them. But she had worked hard during the years she had with them, to instill a loving nature and a reverence for God, that she

knew would carry them through life. "And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them."
