Jan Dayle Fancler, 70, of Humansville, Missouri passed away Friday, August 28, 2015 at his farm. He was one of 4 children born in Bunceton, Missouri to Walter (Bill) and Lucille Fancler. After his graduation from Bunceton High School he enlisted in the U S Navy and served during the Vietnam War. Upon receiving his Honorable Discharge Jan returned home, started a family and began working with his father at Hall & Riley Quarry as a heavy equipment operator. He continued his career as an operator with the Missouri Department of Conservation working in different areas of the state until settling in Humansville, Missouri with his family. Jan spent his retirement farming and spending time with his family and many good friends. Jan was a Master Mason in the Masonic Lodge, he was a member of the Sons of the Confederacy, and a 20 year charter member of the Fancler Big Buck Bonanza which he looked forward to each deer season. He loved working on his farm, enjoyed dancing, country & western music, and took advantage of any opportunity to play his guitar and sing.
