March 10, 1933 - April 12, 2026

Jane Totten Rayl, age 93, passed away on Sunday morning, April 12, 2026, at Parkview Health Care Facility in Bolivar, Missouri, after a short illness.

Jane was born in Sherman, Texas to Harold Wallace and Thelma Ferguson Totten. She graduated from Sherman High School in 1950 and then attended the University of Texas. Jane married Joe F.
