



## Jay Lyman

September 14, 1923 - April 23, 2009

Mr. Jay Lyman, Jr, 85, Aldrich, died Thursday, April 23, 2009 in the Missouri Veterans Home at Mount Vernon. The son of Jay Asa and Jessie (Copeland) Lyman, he was born September 14, 1923 at Aldrich. Jay graduated from Aldrich High School. He served in the Army Air Force from 1943 to 1946 during World War II. A barber and a farmer, he barbered at Aldrich from 1948 to 1966, for 3 years at Walnut Grove and then at the Missouri Chest Hospital in Mount Vernon retiring in 1983. He was a member of the Aldrich United Methodist Church. His parents and brother, Frank X. Lyman, preceded him in death. Survivors include his wife, Annabel; one son and daughter-in-law, Randy and Sue Lyman, Aldrich; one grandson, Aaron Lyman, Springfield; and one sister, Wanda Taylor, Aldrich. Cremation is under the direction of Murray Funeral Home, Bolivar. A memorial service will be held at the Missouri Veterans Cemetery, Springfield Friday, May 1, 2009 at 2:00 PM.
