Jeffrey Len Reynolds, 61, passed away January 24 at his home near Polk, Missouri.

Jeff was born to Hallie and Irene Gladden Reynolds February 13, 1957, in Humansville, Missouri, and grew up on the family farm near Polk. As the youngest of six children, he was close in age with his older nieces and nephews, and they made many good memories on the farm. He attended Polk Elementary School, Bolivar Junior High and Bolivar High School, graduating in the class of 1975.
