



Rev. John Willis McGee

March 27, 1919 - June 29, 2007

Rev. John Willis (Jack) McGee Sr., age 88 passed away on June 29, 2007 at Arbor Terrace in Atlanta, GA.

Rev. McGee was born in St. Clair, MO on March 27, 1919 to Charlotte (Sanders) McGee and Willis Daniel McGee.

He graduated from the University Of Missouri at Columbia with a Bachelors degree in journalism in 1947, and from Perkins School of Theology, Southern Methodist University in Dallas, TX with a Masters of Divinity Degree in 1954.

He served as a minister in the Northeast Texas Conference of the United Methodist Church for over thirty years. After his retirement he served for several years as a chaplain for the Dallas Police Department.

Rev. McGee served four years in the United States Navy during World War II, was assigned to submarine service in the South Pacific and was honorably discharged in 1945. After moving to Atlanta in 1994, Rev. McGee was an active member of Glenn Memorial United Methodist Church and an active volunteer with Atlanta Habitat for Humanity.

Rev. McGee was preceded in death by his parents. He was married for over 60 years to Harriet Winton McGee who passed away on July 8, 2011.

Surviving is two daughters, Marcia McGee Perkins of Charlottesville, VA; Melanie McGee Platt and husband J. McDowell Platt of Atlanta, GA; and one son, John Willis McGee Jr. and wife Kathy of Austin, TX; Also 5 grandchildren, Meredith McGee, Matthew Davenport, Caitlin McGee, Bo Platt and Jake Platt. Two great grandchildren, Eden Eckstrom and Lucy Clauss.

A memorial graveside service will be held at 10:00 AM on Saturday, September 10, 2011 at the Morrisville Cemetery, Morrisville, MO with Donn Ann Hall officiating. Arrangements are under the care and direction of the Butler Funeral Home of Bolivar, MO.
