Karen Ann Phillips age 54 of Bolivar, died at 1:15 PM Friday, November 3, 2006 at her home south of Bolivar.

She worked as a paramedic for Leavenworth County, Kansas EMS, and as a certified nursing assistant for many years before graduating from Idaho State University School of Nursing. She was House Coordinator for Home Court Advantages' SMILE program (Students Mastering Independent Living Education), a residential home for troubled adolescents, in Polk County.

Jesse survives her, as does her precious mother, Doris, her four beloved children, Carrie Peter and husband John of Colorado, Lisa Culbertson of Bolivar, Phillip Riley and his wife Mary Beth of Indiana, and Douglas Phillips and his wife Keisha of Joplin; along with the 12 treasured grandchildren God blessed her life with: Michael, Shayla, Christopher, and Alyssa Peter; Randall and Brittni Culbertson; Matthew, Austin and Hannah Grace Riley; and Brittnie, Dylan, and Jesse Phillips.
