Kelly Eugene Nash, age 57, of Fair Play Missouri, departed this life on Saturday night, December 31, 2011 at Citizens Memorial Hospital in Bolivar, Missouri, following a lengthy battle with cancer.

Kelly was born on January 26, 1954 in Wagner, South Dakota the son of Claude Eugene Nash and Helen Marie (Branough) Nash.

Kelly's father Claude worked in road construction, which required the family to move around the country following the work. Kelly said that he went to thirteen different schools, while this may be a stretch, it was certain that he attended to several. While the family lived in Adrian, Missouri, Kelly graduated from Adrian High School.

Kelly was a man of many talents and interests. He was in road construction with his father for most of his career.
