LaVonne Marie Mallan, 59, Humansville, died Saturday, December 5, 2009. The daughter of Henry and Dorothy (Wimmer) Mallan, she was born May 27, 1950 in Austin, Minnesota. LaVonne was a graduate of St. Benedict's Catholic College, St. Joseph, Minnesota. For two years she taught school and later was employed by REM, Rochester, Minnesota working with and providing care for special needs clients. She was employed in customer service by Longview Fibre, Fridley, Minnesota, retiring after 15 years of service. LaVonne loved animals and the outdoors, caring for her dogs, goats and horses. Her love of animals led her to be a volunteer at Cause for Paws at Stockton. Her gentle acceptance and patience comforted many and was exhibited working with Special Olympics as a Special Olympics coach. She was also a volunteer for the Citizens Memorial Hospital Auxiliary. LaVonne had been a resident of Humansville for the past year, moving here from Oak Grove, Minnesota where she lived from 1990 to 2008.
