September 6, 1929 - January 4, 2008

Leattie L. Russell, age 78 was born on September 6, 1929 to Thomas E. Ball and Omah McWilliams Ball, and passed away on January 4, 2008 at the Citizens Memorial Hospital after a short illness.

She was born and lived her earlier life in Omer (Cedar County) MO. She was saved at an early age in the Methodist Church at Omer.

In the early 40's she moved with her family to Bolivar, MO where she graduated from Bolivar High School in 1947.
