Lennie Leona (Granny) Kennicutt, 90, of Flemington passed away Sunday, March 24, 2013 at her residence. She was one of 4 children born in Paris, Arkansas to Albert Lewis and Lennie LeeOna Struble. Lennie, affectionately known as Granny, was a high school graduate and attended 2 years of college. She married Russell Vernon Kennicutt on March 15, 1944 and they were married almost 51 years before he passed away February 26, 1995. She was a Christian and attended the Pentecostal Church. She loved to bowl, sometimes participating in as many as 5 leagues each week. She bowled several 275 point games in league play with trophies and awards to signify her accomplishments. She was an avid fisherman who was not always concerned with making the catch but was just content with making the effort. She loved being in the shop with her husband doing woodworking crafts and while they were able they enjoyed traveling together as well. She and Russell were very generous and gracious, opening their home to family and friends who needed a temporary residence. Granny was preceded in death by her parents, siblings and husband Russell. She is survived by daughter Karen Pierce and her companion Cliff Haney with whom she has lived the past 18 years; her son Russell Vernon Kennicutt and his wife Cammie of Humansville; grandson Dustin Knight; granddaughters Shauna and Jessee Kennicutt and 6 great-grandchildren. A memorial service to honor Granny Kennicutt will be held at 2:00 PM Tuesday, April 2 at Murray Funeral Home in Humansville officiated by Chaplain James O. Friend.
