Leo Glenn Walker, 85, Bolivar, died Thursday, June 14, 2007 in Citizens Memorial Hospital. The son of Robert and Nancy (Carroll) Walker, he was born May 23, 1922 at Sentinel. Leo was a graduate of Emma D. High School at Goodson. He served in the U. S. Army during World War II from April 1944 to May 1946. He was a member of Sentinel Missionary Baptist Church and Howard S. Keeling American Legion Post #138. Leo and Berniece Kelley were married September 4, 1955. They lived many years in Kansas City before returning to Bolivar in 1990. Leo was an electrician for Atcheson, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad, retiring after 31 years. His parents, 2 sisters, Zula Inglis and Opal Root, and 4 brothers, Herschel Walker, Virgil Walker, Russell Walker and Creed Walker, preceded him in death. Survivors include his wife, Berniece, of the home; 2 sisters, Mabel Roberts and Jewell Roberts, both of Polk; and many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews; other relatives and friends. Funeral services will be 2:00 PM Saturday, June 16, 2007 at Murray Funeral Home, Bolivar with Brother Glenn Roberts officiating. Music will be by Tammie Kelley.
