### LEON SHULER

Leon Shuler, age 88, went home to the Lord on Sunday, July 29th, 2007 in Gardnerville, NV where he resided. He was born December 12, 1918 in Aldrich, Missouri to Albert and Ella Shuler. At 18, he briefly attended Springfield University on a basketball scholarship. Cut short by an injury, he moved to southern California to be near his brother. He went to work for Bell Telephone until being drafted into the U.S. Army, serving in WWII and the Korean War. He then returned to California Bell, working in CA & NV until retiring in 1977. Real estate kept him active for the next several years until his wife also retired then enabling them to travel by motor home throughout the Midwest to visit family, as well as taking trips to Alaska, Mexico, Canada & Israel.

Moving from Las Vegas to Gardnerville, the Shulers became actively involved with their church family at Living Word Christian Fellowship. A memorial service will be held there at a later date, which will be announced.

Predeceasing Leon were his parents, 2 brothers and 2 sisters and his 1st wife, Virginia. Survivors include his beloved wife, Frances of Gardnerville, daughters Elizabeth Ortiz of Santa Clarita, CA, Margaret Shuler of Fountain Hills, AZ, four (4) granddaughters, nine (9) great grandchildren and three (3)

great-great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, August 6, 2007 at 2:00 PM in the Butler Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. William C. Moseley officiating.
