Mrs. Leora Rosella Bobbie Egert, age 96, of Springfield, Missouri, passed to her Heavenly home on September 27, 2011 at Windsor Healthcare & Rehabilitation Center in Windsor, Missouri.

She was born November 5, 1914 in Toledo, Ohio, the daughter of Ferdinand J. Miller and Mary (Lassond) Miller.
