Leroy Seiner, 82, of Humansville passed away Wednesday, July 3, 2013 at Mercy Hospital in Springfield. The son of Cecil and Esther Seiner, he was born July 6, 1930 in Bolivar. Leroy graduated from eighth grade at South Ward Grade School in Bolivar. He attended high school for a short time but left school to work on the family farm. Leroy was united in marriage to Jo Maxine Harville September 17, 1950. They were married nearly 60 years before her death. After working in the Kansas City area while also milking cows on his farm in Excelsior Springs, Leroy and Jo returned to Polk County to the family farm, eventually moving to Humansville where they purchased a farm and began their dairy operation. They later expanded to include raising and showing Missouri Fox Trotter horses. Leroy and Jo shared an immense passion for their cattle and horses. Leroy was a member of Mt. Gilead Methodist Church where he served as song leader. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife Jo, his parents, and infant son and a sister, Geraldine Effenbeck. He is survived by four daughters: Barbara Wegrzyn and her husband Jim, of Humansville, Marsha Vaughn of Weaubleau, Janice Walker and her husband Randall of Bolivar, Donna Glaser and her husband Shawn of Humansville; sister Maxine Smith of Bolivar; brother Bobby Gene Seiner of Aurora; grandchildren Christy and Kent McNeely; step-grandchildren Nathan Walker, Clayton Walker and Chris Wegrzyn; step-great-grandchildren Lane and Bailey Walker; several nieces, nephews and a host of friends. He is also survived by his cherished Beagle, Joe. Funeral services for Leroy Seiner will
