December 3, 1919 - February 1, 2014

Letha Flynn, 94, of Flemington, Missouri passed away Saturday, February 1, 2014 at Citizens Memorial Hospital in Bolivar. She was one of 4 children born to Tillman and Mary Jane Park in Elk Mountain, Wyoming. Letha married Ralph W. Flynn, Jr., on July 6, 1941 after a 2 week courtship. Letha was working at a hatchery in Iowa at the time and went home with a girlfriend for Sunday dinner where she met her girlfriends' brother Ralph. On the second Sunday after their meeting they were married in St. Joseph, Missouri. They lived in northwest Missouri until moving back to this area in 1976. He preceded her in death on February 7, 1995 after celebrating 53 years of marriage together. Letha was a homemaker to her family. She enjoyed gardening, canning, and was quite a collector of family memorabilia. She was a seamstress for family and neighbors which developed into a local business. She did sewing on President Johnson's daughter's wedding dress and also on fancy western suits for trick riders that performed in Madison Square Garden. She loved to dance and loved people. She was a faithful attendee of the annual meeting of the Park Grove Christian Church each August for the past 52 years eagerly anticipating the next meeting. She was preceded in death by her parents and siblings Lorene Corbin, Lois Jackson and Wayman Park. She is survived by daughter Sharron Welch and her husband George of Flemington; 6 grandchildren; 13 great-grandchildren; 4 great-great-grandchildren; nieces and nephews. Funeral services for Letha Flynn will be held 1:00 PM Tuesday, February 4, 2014 at Murray Funeral Home in

Humansville with burial to follow at the Park Grove Cemetery near Lowry City. Visitation will be held from 12 - 1 PM prior to the service.
