He was always a hard, dedicated worker. After school, he would go home to do chores, including working the cows and pigs, and baling hay.

As an adult, Lewis continued to work cows as well as own and operate a barber shop in Humansville for 50 years. Lewis met and was able to know many people who sat in his chair. Through his business as well as private gestures he loved to give back to his community.

Lewis enjoyed working on any type of engine he could. He was able to fix an old H Farmall tractor that the owner believed to be seized, and it is still used to this day. He also enjoyed cars, particularly his 1967 Chevelle.

Lewis loved his family dearly, and particularly loved to watch them play sports. He would play with them as often as he could.

Lewis is preceded in death by his daughter, Karen Sawyers, as well as his brother, Jim Sawyers.

Lewis is survived by his son, David Sawyers and wife Sandy of Lebanon, MO, as well as his grandsons, Neal Sawyers, Hunter Sawyers, and Landon Sawyers. He is also survived by his brother, Tom Sawyers.
