Lindell Laverne Hunter, son of Ralph L. Hunter and Olah (Sawyer) Hunter, was born on March 27, 1922 in Patterson, MO. He went to be with the Lord on Saturday, October 15, 2022 in the Parkview Healthcare Facility in Bolivar, MO. At the age of 89 years of age Lin received Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior and enjoyed the following years in his church of Heritage Baptist Church in Bolivar. He was a graduate of Patterson High School in Patterson, MO. and also attended the University of Missouri. Lin loved to travel and spend time with family and friends.
