



## Lois Irene Jackson

October 1, 1922 - January 23, 2012

Lois Irene Jackson, 89, of Bolivar, passed away Monday, January 23, 2012, at Citizens Memorial Healthcare Facility. She was born in Elk Mountain, Wyoming, the daughter of Tillman and Mary (Church) Park. She married Jesse W. Jackson in Boulder City, Nevada, on January 24, 1943, and he preceded her in death in 1990 after 47 years of marriage. Lois was primarily a homemaker dedicated to her family but worked occasionally as a seamstress, working with clothing, draperies, and upholstery. Lois was of the Catholic faith and was very active serving in her church Altar Society at St. Catherine Church in Humansville and after moving to Bolivar, in the Altar Society at Sacred Heart Church in Bolivar. She was also quite active in the Polk County Historical Society as long as her health permitted. Lois was preceded in death by her parents, brother Wayman Dale Park of Fairfax, Missouri; and sister Lorraine Corbin of Albuquerque, New Mexico. She is survived by her 4 children, Herbert W.
