



## Lorin James Stuck

November 30, 1913 - October 13, 2012

Lorin James Stuck, 98, of Collins, Missouri, passed away Saturday evening October 13, 2012, at the Big Spring Care Center in Humansville. Lorin was one of 7 children born to James and Ella Albertson Stuck in Heart Lake, Alberta, Canada. Lorin moved to the U.S. and became a U.S. citizen. Due to color-blindness he could not serve in the military so he enlisted in the Civilian Conservation Corps. Lorin married Mamie (Jean) Leppen on January 7, 1938 and she preceded him in death November 26, 1993 after 55 years of marriage. They lived in the Delton, Michigan area where he was a general contractor on construction projects both large and small throughout his career. He was a Mason and also served for 27 years as a school board member for the Delton-Kellogg School system in Delton. At the age of 88 Lorin married Ruth Maners who still survives him. They moved permanently to Leesburg, Florida in 2004 and enjoyed their marriage of 11 years. In April of this year Lorin moved to Collins, Missouri to be near his daughter Lauren and her family. Lorin was preceded in death by his parents, wife Jean, son Vernon Stuck, brothers Roy, Harold, Irving, Thurlow, Murray Stuck and their sister Mildred. He is survived by his wife Ruth; daughters Lauren Baldwin and her husband Lowell of Collins, Laura Rahe and her husband Dennis of Oshtemo, Michigan, Sandra Lewis and her husband Wilbur of Omro, Wisconsin; grandchildren Cynthia, Teresa, Dan, and Ernie; several great-grandchildren; numerous nieces and nephews. Gravesite services and inurnment will take place in Hickory Corners Cemetery, Hickory Corners, Michigan in early
