Mamie Ellen Merrill, 92, Fair Play, died Friday, March 20, 2009 in Citizens Memorial Hospital. The daughter of Robert Ledbetter and Melvina (Gent) Stogner, she was born February 26, 1917 at Scuddy, Kentucky. During World War II she worked in a munitions plant loading detonators into anti-aircraft shells. She later worked in the restaurant business for 30 years as a waitress, manager and owner. She moved to Fair Play 18 years ago from Heber, Arizona. She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary, the Aldrich United Methodist Church and United Methodist Women. Her parents, husband and 5 brothers preceded her in death.
